



2019 Great Fish Color Run and Community Celebration T-Shirt Design Contest

When: Contest opens for design submissions on Monday, April 8, 2019 and closes Friday, June 7, 2019.

Where: Designs may be submitted to contact@whitefishcommunityfoundation.org or dropped off at the Whitefish Community Foundation (the Foundation), 214 W. 2nd Street, Whitefish, MT 59937

Who: The winning t-shirt design will be unveiled at the Great Fish Community Challenge Launch Party on July 25, 2019. Over 600 t-shirts will be produced by Whitefish Community Foundation's vendor and distributed for the 2019 Great Fish Color Run and Community Celebration on September 7, 2019 to nonprofit volunteers, Community Foundation Board of Directors and staff, and runners registered to participate in the event.

Why:

- Show your support for the Great Fish Community Challenge and the Great Fish Color Run!
- Create an original design expressing what this annual event means to you, and win a \$500 grant for the 2019 Great Fish Community Challenge participating nonprofit of your choice!
- See your original design on over 600 people at the Color Fun Run and Community Celebration and spot your original design around town for years to come!

How does it work?

Artistic Guidelines

1. Design does not need to include the Great Fish Community Challenge logo. The logo will be printed on the t-shirt in addition to the design.
2. Design should be full color and will be printed on a white t-shirt.
3. Designs must include the following words "Color Run" and "2019" somewhere within the design.

Submission Guidelines

1. Designs must be original and submitted by, or on behalf of, the designer and with the designer's direct consent. **Adults (18+) must submit on behalf of minors.**
2. By entering the contest, the submitter certifies that the design is original and submission of the design and use of the design by the Foundation does not infringe on trademark, copyright, or any other intellectual property or other laws.
3. Designers must agree to the full Official Contest Rules (below) which includes assigning the copyright to unrestricted public domain.
4. By submitting a design, the designer and submitter grant the Foundation the right to reproduce, sell, trademark, copyright, publicly display, expand, revise, improve, or otherwise use the design in any manner.
5. Designs should be suitable for print media as well as for use in online channels. JPG, Adobe Illustrator, or Photoshop files will be accepted but EPS files are preferred. Hand-drawn designs will be accepted on 8.5 x 11-inch paper. Hand drawn designs will be converted to electronic format, therefore all colors need to be in solid blocks that do not include shading gradients.
6. Submit designs by email to contact@whitefishcommunityfoundation.org or deliver to 214 W. 2nd Street, Whitefish, MT 59937. You may submit more than one design. The 2019 Official Release Form, completed and signed, MUST accompany each submission.

Official Contest Rules

I have read the following OFFICIAL CONTEST RULES for the 2019 Great Fish Color Run and Community Celebration T-Shirt Design Contest and I agree to the following Official Contest Rules:

1. The design contest opens for entry submissions on Monday, April 8, 2019 at 12:01 am MST and ends Friday, June 7, 2019 at 11:59 pm MST.
2. All entries must be an original creation of the designer that have never been published or publicly disseminated.
3. Entries cannot contain trademarks, copyrighted material, or other protected, confidential, or proprietary images, logos, words, marks, or designs.
4. Designs my NOT contain, as determined by the Foundation, in its sole and absolute discretion, any content that: is sexually explicit, obscene, offensive, violent, disparaging, defamatory, slanderous, or illegal; derogatory towards any ethnic, racial, gender, religious, professional, age, or other group or class; vulgar, profane, or pornographic; promotes alcohol, illegal drugs, tobacco, firearms/weapons (or the use of any of the foregoing); promotes a particular political agenda; or communicates messages or images inconsistent with the positive images and/or good will to which the Foundation wishes to associate.
5. The prize is a \$500 grant to a 2019 Great Fish Community Challenge participating nonprofit of the contest winner's choice, and 5 free T-shirts.
6. All entries become and remain the property of the Foundation. The Foundation will not return any entries to the submitter. The Foundation may reproduce, sell, trademark,

copyright, publicly display, expand, revise, improve, or otherwise use the design in any manner at any time. Designers may display their own design(s) in a portfolio or personal collection but may not sell or reproduce the design or any design that is confusingly similar to or derived from the design for any other purpose once submitted to the contest.

7. A panel of judges representing the Foundation will choose the winning submission.
8. The entries must be received by 11:59 pm MST, June 7, 2019. Designs may be submitted in person at the Foundation office or by email at contact@whitefishcommunityfoundation.org.
9. FORM OF ENTRIES:
 - The entry may be hand-drawn or printed on 8-1/2" x 11" paper, or the entry may be in any of the following art file formats if submitted electronically: JPG, Adobe Illustrator, Photoshop or EPS.
 - The entry must be accompanied by the Official Release Form, signed by the designer or the designer's parent or legal guardian if the designer is a minor.
10. The Foundation reserves the right to pick one entry, more than one entry, or no entries as the winning entry.
11. If the Foundation picks an entry as the winning entry, it may produce and sell t-shirts with the winning design but it is not obligated to do so.
12. The Foundation reserves the right to terminate this contest at any time, effective on the date of issuing the termination notice. The Foundation does not need to give you notice prior to the date of termination.
13. To submit an entry, the submitter must sign the 2019 Official Great Fish Color Run and Community Celebration T-Shirt Design Release Form (below) in which he or she acknowledges that he or she understands the Official Contest Rules, and assigns, transfers, and conveys all rights and interest in the design to the Foundation.
14. This contest is subject to all federal, state, and local laws.

T-Shirt Design Release Form

I am submitting a t-shirt design with this form, and I hereby assign, transfer, and convey any and all rights and interest in the design to the Whitefish Community Foundation (the Foundation). I agree that the design I submit becomes property of the Foundation and that the design will not be returned to me.

I acknowledge that I have read and understand the Official Contest Rules, and my t-shirt design is in compliance with those rules.

I represent that I am the original creator of the design (or the parent or legal guardian of the original creator of the design) and submission of the design and use of the design by the Foundation does not infringe on or violate trademark, copyright, or any other intellectual property or other laws. I will indemnify and hold the Foundation, its directors, officers, employees, affiliates, and subsidiaries, agents, and contractors harmless from and pay any loss, debt, liability, damage, obligation, claim, demand, judgment, or settlement of any nature or kind, known or unknown, liquidated or unliquidated, including without limitation, all reasonable costs and expenses incurred including all reasonable litigation costs and attorneys' fees arising out of or relating to a claim that submission of the design and use of the design by the Foundation infringes on or violates any trademark, copyright, intellectual property or other laws; infringes on any privacy, confidentiality, or privilege rights; or arising out of or related to a breach of the Official Contest Rules.

I agree that if I win the contest, I authorize the Foundation, without additional compensation, to use my name and likeness or photograph for promotional purposes in any manner and in any medium (including without limitation the internet, written or email communications, brochures, videos, slides, radio, television, film) that the Foundation deems appropriate.

If I submit more than one entry, I will submit this signed form with each entry.

I agree that if I win this contest, the \$500.00 grant to a 2019 Great Fish Community Challenge participating nonprofit of my choice and 5 free t-shirts is fair and adequate compensation for my contest entry.
