



GLACIER RESTAURANT GROUP - R.I.S.E. SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

This program is managed by the Whitefish Community Foundation, and will award two, \$2,500 scholarships in 2022:

To apply for a Glacier Restaurant Group Restaurant Industry Scholarship, you must be an eligible employee, or the child or legal dependent of an eligible Glacier Restaurant Group employee.

The application deadline is Thursday, April 7, 2022 at 4:00 p.m. MST. Late applications will not be accepted.

Awards will be announced in July 2022

REQUIREMENTS:

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be an eligible employee or the child or legal dependent of an eligible employee at one of the GRG eligible entities.

- The eligible employee must have been employed by the Employer within the year prior to the date of the application
- Have earned a high school or current college G.P.A. of 3.5 or higher (high school or college transcripts must be provided)
- Preference will be given to individuals with a proven history of community involvement/volunteerism
- Provide a letter of recommendation from a current or former teacher/professor/instructor written in the last two years, and a letter of recommendation from a current or former employer or community involvement supervisor (NOTE: Letters of recommendation will be uploaded by the person providing the reference, not by the applicant.)
- Intend to enroll at a post-secondary educational institution in the fall of 2022 (all scholarships are paid directly to the institution)
- Submit a completed application by the application deadline
